KS95 - TEACHER OF THE WEEK CONTEST

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY, PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE CHANCES OF WINNING

- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Anyone 13 years of age or older from Minnesota or Wisconsin may nominate any eligible teacher in the KS95 Teacher of the Week Contest ("Contest"). Individuals/teachers nominated must be 18 years or older, residents of Minnesota or Wisconsin, and must be a teacher in Grades Preschool-12 at a private or public school within **sixty (60) miles** of Minneapolis/St. Paul, Minnesota, to be eligible to win. In order to be eligible to win a prize in this Contest, you cannot have won or accepted any prize from KS95 within 30 days prior to the awarding of a prize to you in this contest, or won any prize or combination of prizes with a total stated value of \$600.00 or more from KS95 within 60 days prior to the awarding of a prize to you in this contest. These restrictions apply even if you reject the prize. Employees of KSTP-FM, LLC, Hubbard Radio, LLC, TCL (including their subsidiaries, affiliates, parent or related companies, and their immediate families), are not eligible to enter. Any one participating in this contest or claiming a prize in this Contest in violation of these rules will be disqualified from participating in KS95 contests for a period of one year. A person may only qualify once for this Contest.
- 2. HOW TO ENTER: We are looking for stories about Preschool-12 teachers who have gone "above and beyond the call of duty" to help students. In order to enter, log on to www.ks95.com ("Website") from 12:00:01 AM Central Time ("CT") on September 3, 2019, through 11:59:59 PM CT on May 8, 2019 ("Entry Period"), and click on the "Teacher of the Week" icon to enter; complete the entry, which must include your name and telephone number, your relationship to the person you are nominating, along with the full name of the Preschool-12 teacher you are nominating, the school/address/telephone number and e-mail address of the school he/she teaches at, the grade/subject he/she teaches and a story about this teacher in 150 words or less. Preschool-12 teachers may be nominated by students, fellow teachers, co-workers, friends, parents, spouses, etc. A teacher may not nominate himself/herself. KS95 is not responsible for problems accessing the website, technical or atmospheric conditions that disrupt the completion of the entry, or any other problems which might or might not result from this contest. Listeners may enter this contest more than once, but may only nominate any given teacher once.

3. HOW THE WINNERS ARE CHOSEN:

a. Weekly Winners: From all eligible entries received, each Friday during the Contest (beginning Friday, September 13, 2019, and ending on May 8, 2020) in the 6am hour during the KS95 Morning Show, the KS95 Morning Show will announce one (1) Weekly Winner. The Weekly Winner will be chosen by a panel of KS95 judges the day before each Weekly Winner is announced, in their sole and absolute discretion, using the following judging criteria: the teacher's overall involvement with students (25%), what the teacher has done "above and beyond the call of duty" (25%), the impact the teacher has had on student's lives (25%), and the dedication to the teaching profession (25%). The teacher described in the story who receives the highest score each week during the Contest will be deemed a Weekly Winner, and will win a Qualifying Prize and that Weekly Winner's name will also be put in the random drawing for a chance to win the Grand Prize, to be held at the end of the year dinner on May 20, 2020 at a to-be-announced location in the Twin Cities metro area. Due to holidays, KS95 will NOT choose a Weekly Winner on November 22, 2019, December 13, 2019 or December 27, 2019.

- b. <u>Monthly Winners</u>: On the last Friday of each month (except for Nov and Dec, which will occur the 3rd Friday), beginning September 27, 2019 thru April 24, 2019, the weekly winner on that Friday will also receive a Monthly Prize.
- c. <u>Grand Prize Winners</u>: The 33 Weekly Winners as set forth in Section 2 a. above will be invited to attend a dinner honoring the Teachers of the Week, to be held on **May 20, 2020** at a to-be-determined location in the Twin Cities metro area and at a time to be determined by Sponsor (the "Teachers of the Week Event"). Immediately following the dinner at the Teachers of the Week Event, Sponsor will randomly select two (2) Grand Prize winners. Sponsor will announced the Grand Prize winners at the Event. The Grand Prize winners need **NOT** be present to win. Odds of winning a Grand Prize is 1:17.

Thirty-Three (33) Qualifying Prizes: Each of the 33 Weekly Winners will each receive the following Qualifying Prize: an engraved plaque from KS95 recognizing him/her as KS95's Teacher of the Week, and the following: a KS95 prize pack (t-shirt, pens/pencils) and the teacher and a guest will be invited to attend a dinner honoring the Teachers of the Week to be held on May 20, 2020 at a to-be-determined location. ARV: \$50.00 each. The weekly qualifying prizes will be delivered to the winning teacher's school.

Eight (8) Monthly Prizes: Each Monthly Winner will receive the following Monthly Prize: one (1) 55 inch TCL TV, model 55S517. ARV: \$379.99 each. The TV will be delivered to the winning teacher's school.

Two (2) Grand Prizes: There will be two (2) Grand Prizes awarded. Each Grand Prize winner will receive \$1,000 in cash for himself/herself, \$1,000 in cash will be donated to the Grand Prize winner's school, and one (1) 55 inch TCL TV, model 55S517.
