

## KS95 - TEACHER OF THE WEEK CONTEST

### OFFICIAL RULES

1. HOW TO ENTER: NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. We are looking for stories about Preschool-12 teachers who have gone “above and beyond the call of duty” to help students. In order to enter, log on to ks95.com from 12:00:01 AM Central Time (“CT”) on Tuesday, September 4 2018, through 11:59:59 PM CT on Wednesday, May 8, 2019 (“Entry Period”), and click on the "Teacher of the Week" icon to enter; complete the entry, which must include your name and telephone number, your relationship to the person you are nominating, along with the full name of the Preschool-12 teacher you are nominating, the school/address/telephone number and e-mail address of the school he/she teaches at, the grade/subject he/she teaches and a story about this teacher in 150 words or less. Preschool-12 teachers may be nominated by students, fellow teachers, co-workers, friends, parents, spouses, etc. A teacher may not nominate himself/herself. KS95 is not responsible for problems accessing the website, technical or atmospheric conditions that disrupt the completion of the entry, or any other problems which might or might not result from this contest. Listeners may enter this contest more than once, but may only nominate any given teacher once.
  
2. HOW THE WINNERS ARE CHOSEN:
  - a. Weekly Winners: From all eligible entries received, each Friday during the Contest (beginning Friday, September 14, 2018, and ending Friday, May 10, 2019) in the 6am hour during the KS95 Morning Show, the KS95 Morning Show will announce one (1) Weekly Winner. The Weekly Winner will be chosen by a panel of KS95 judges the day before each Weekly Winner is announced, in their sole and absolute discretion, using the following judging criteria: the teacher's overall involvement with students (25%), what the teacher has done “above and beyond the call of duty” (25%), the impact the teacher has had on student's lives (25%), and the dedication to the teaching profession (25%). The teacher described in the story who receives the highest score each week during the Contest will be deemed a Weekly Winner, and will win a Qualifying Prize and that Weekly Winner’s name will also be put in the random drawing for a chance to win the Grand or a Runner UP prize, to be held at the end of the year dinner on **May 22, 2019** at Radisson Blu Mall of America. Due to holidays, KS95 will NOT choose a Weekly Winner on November 23, 2018, December 14, 2018 or December 28, 2018.
  
  - b. Monthly Winners: On the following Fridays of each month, beginning September 28, 2018 thru April 26, 2019, the weekly winner on that Friday will also receive a Monthly Prize (exception December Monthly Prize will be awarded on Friday, December 21, 2018):  
  
September 28, 2018, October 26, 2018, November 16, 2018, December 21, 2018, January 25, 2019, February 22, 2019, March 29, 2019 and April 26, 2019.
  
  - c. Grand and Runner Up Winners: The 32 Weekly Winners as set forth in Section 2 a. above will be invited to attend a dinner honoring the Teachers of the Week, to be held on **Wednesday, May 22, 2019** at Radisson Blu Mall of America at a time to be determined by Sponsor (the “Teachers of the Week Event”). Immediately following the dinner at the Teachers of the Week Event, Sponsor will randomly select one (1) Weekly Winner to be the Grand Prize winner and one (1) Weekly Winner to be the Runner Up winner. Sponsor will announced the Grand Prize and Runner Up prize winner’s at the Event. The Grand

Prize winner need **NOT** be present to win, however, to be named the Runner Up prize winner, that potential Runner Up prize winner **MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN THE RUNNER UP PRIZE**. Odds of winning a Grand or Runner Up prize are 1:32.

3. PRIZES AND APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUES (“ARV’s”)/HOW TO CLAIM PRIZES.

**Thirty-Two (32) Qualifying Prizes:** Each of the 32 Weekly Winners will each receive the following Qualifying Prize: an engraved plaque from KS95 recognizing him/her as KS95's Teacher of the Week, and the following: a KS95 prize pack (t-shirt, pens/pencils) and the teacher and a guest will be invited to attend a dinner honoring the Teachers of the Week to be held on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at Radisson Blu Mall of America. ARV: \$50.00 each. The weekly qualifying prizes will be delivered to the winning teacher's school.

**Eight (8) Monthly Prizes:** Each Monthly Winner will receive the following Monthly Prize: one (1) 43” TCL TV, Model 43S517. ARV: \$349.99 each. The TV will be delivered to the winning teacher's school.

**One (1) Grand Prize Winner:** There will be one grand prize awarded. \$1,000 in cash for himself/herself, \$1,000 in cash will be donated to the Grand Prize winner's school, and one (1) 55” TCL TV, Model 55S405. ARV: \$379.99. Grand Prize winner may pick up their Grand Prize at the KS95 Studios located at 3415 University Avenue, St. Paul, MN 55114 within **ten (10) days** of winning the Grand Prize. This is to verify that the prize is being given to the qualified winner. Failure to comply with this deadline shall be deemed to be the winner's forfeiture of his or her right to claim a prize.

**One (1) Runner Up Prize Winner.** There will be one runner up prize awarded at the dinner at Radisson Blu Mall of America on Wednesday, May 22, 2019. In addition to the qualifying prize, the runner up prize winner will receive one (1) 55” TCL TV, Model 55S405 (ARV: \$379.99). A random drawing will take place from all teachers in attendance to determine the runner up prize winner. Must be present to win.

A qualified winner must also meet the eligibility requirements as set forth in Paragraph 4 of these rules. The prizes winners are responsible for all applicable income taxes. A 1099 form may be submitted to all appropriate taxing authorities. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all federal, state, and local taxes, if any, associated with donation acceptance by the grand prize winner's school are selected school's responsibility.

Each winner must prove he/she is a qualified winner by presenting identification acceptable to KS95 (e.g., state drivers license; state issued identification card; valid passport with address verification; or birth certificate with social security card and photo identification and address verification). If a winner cannot prove she is a qualified winner, the prize will not be awarded. All unclaimed prizes remain the property of KS95. The grand prize will not be issued to the winner unless a social security number is presented.

4. **ELIGIBILITY:** Anyone 13 and older from Minnesota or Wisconsin may nominate any eligible teacher. Individuals/teachers nominated must be 18 years or older, residents of Minnesota or Wisconsin, and must be a teacher in Grades Preschool-12 at a private or public school within sixty (60) miles of Minneapolis/St. Paul, Minnesota, to be eligible to win. In order to be eligible to win a prize in this contest, you cannot have won or accepted any prize from KS95 within 30 days prior to the awarding of a prize to you in this contest, or won any prize or combination of prizes with a total stated value of \$600.00 or more

from KS95 within 60 days prior to the awarding of a prize to you in this contest. These restrictions apply even if you reject the prize. Employees of KSTP-FM, LLC, Hubbard Radio, LLC, Bethel University Graduate and Adult Programs, Old Home Foods, Radisson Blu Mall of America and TCL (including their subsidiaries, affiliates, parent or related companies, and their immediate families), are not eligible to enter. Any one participating in this contest or claiming a prize in this contest in violation of these rules will be disqualified from participating in KS95 contests for a period of one year. A person may only qualify once for this contest.
